


Glasgow's LEZ zone - be prepared!

A Low Emission Zone (LEZ) is coming into effect in the city centre of Glasgow on 1 June 2023 which may affect accessibility to some of our centres by car. To find out if your vehicle meets the minimum requirements, you can enter your registration number on the LEZ website at: https://www.lowemissionzones.scot/vehicle-registration-checker

If your vehicle meets the minimum requirements to drive in the LEZ you will not have to make any changes to your route, however you may need to check the LEZ map if your vehicle does not meet the minimum requirements in order to avoid affected roads. You can use <u>Traffic Scotland's interactive map</u> to help you plan your journey. LEZ boundaries can be selected under the road facilities tab.



Accessing our Hope Street centre

While our Hope Street centre will not be accessible by cars that do not meet the LEZ requirements, it is well connected to local transport links. It is located directly opposite Central Station, as well as being on several bus routes, and within walking distance of Queen Street Station and St Enoch/Buchanan Street Subway Stations (several subway stops outside the city centre Park and Ride facilities with subways running from 06.30am until 11.40pm Monday-Saturday (see https://www.spt.co.uk/travel-with-spt/subway/subway-time-tables).

Accessing our Sandyford Place and Woodside Place centres

Our Sandyford Place and Woodside Place centres are also easily accessible by bus routes and St George's Cross Subway Station. However, we have some suggestions that, to the best of our knowledge, permit access to our Sandyford Place and Woodside Place Centres by car while avoiding LEZ affected roads (please check your route on the Traffic Scotland website to ensure accuracy).



- On the M8 Eastbound, take the A82 exit for Dumbarton, follow signs for Aberfoyle (A81), continue on A804, then take Berkley Street to Sandyford Place/Woodside Place
- On the M77 Northbound, take the M74 exit towards Carlisle/M8 West/Greenock, then take Exit 1 for Tradeston (A8). Turn left onto Paisley Road, turn right onto Govan Road and then take Finnieston Street (the Squinty Bridge) across the river. Turn left onto Argyle Street then take Berkeley Street to Sandyford Place/Woodside Place.
- On the M74 take the exit towards Tradeston (A8). Turn right onto Carnoustie Street then left onto Paisley Road, turn right onto Govan Road and then take Finnieston Street (the Squinty Bridge) across the river. Turn left onto Argyle Street then take Berkeley Street to Sandyford Place/Woodside Place.
- On the M8 Westbound at Junction 18 use the right lane to exit towards Charing Cross/Kelvingrove.
 Merge onto Newton Street (A804), turn right onto Bath Street and continue on to Berkeley Street then Sandyford Place/Woodside Place.
